This agreement is between Carlton Parish Council (the PC), and the Carlton Defibrillator Group (the DG).

- 1. The PC agrees that a defibrillator may be installed in the Village Information Kiosk, so that it may be accessed quickly in an emergency. The PC and the DG agree that the defibrillator is and shall remain wholly the property of the DG.
- 2. The PC agrees that the defibrillator may be connected to the existing unmetered electricity supply in the Information Kiosk (subject to the agreement of Central Networks), that it will be added to the PC's MPAN Inventory and that the PC will pay for the electricity consumed.
- 3. The PC agrees to include the defibrillator in the PCs insurance policy and to pay all premiums. This policy has an excess of £250 per claim.
- 4. The DG agrees to arrange and pay for the installation of the de-fibrillator in the Information Kiosk, including connections to the electricity supply. The PC is subject to a condition that any electrical work in the Kiosk must be certified by a competent electrician. The DG agrees to provide the PC with a copy of the appropriate certificate.
- 5. The DG agrees to arrange and pay for the testing, maintenance, repair and servicing of the defibrillator.
- 6. The DG agrees that it will be wholly responsible for the management and training of volunteers and for the use of the defibrillator.
- 7. The PC may require the defibrillator to be removed by passing a resolution to that effect and giving the DG three months notice. The DG agrees that it will disconnect and remove the defibrillator at its own expense within one month if such a resolution is made.
